RACE 1 – WEEDING PARTY HIRE - MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE– 2100 METRES

PRINCESS SOPHIE was incorrectly shown in the race book as not wearing blinkers when in fact a stable return was lodged on Wednesday 28 October.

EGYPTIAN PRINCESS over raced in the early and middle stages.

PRINCESS SOPHIE blundered at the crossing near the 1600 metres.

Jockey M Munday (EGYPTIAN PRINCESS) was found guilty under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 400 metres he allowed his mount to shift ground inwards when insufficiently clear of URESHII TORI resulting in that mare being inconvenienced and losing position. Jockey Munday's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of 2 Tasmanian race meetings from midnight tonight until midnight 8 November 2009. In arriving at penalty Stewards took into account Jockey Munday's good riding record.

KLUTOS hung out rounding the home turn.

EGYPTIAN PRINCESS was held up prior to entering the home straight and in the early stages of the home straight.

Jockey S Maskiell (ARCTIC SPRING) stated that mid race when the pace eased he elected to shift three wide to improve his position and the mare failed to respond. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Jockey L Coffey (TELEROSS) pleaded guilty under AR 137(A)(5)(a)(ii) in that he used the whip on three (3) additional occasions before the 100 metres. Jockey Coffey was fined the sum of \$200.

RACE 2 – TRC HOTEL LIQUOR STAX 3YO SUPERVOBIS MAIDEN PLATE (1) – 1100 METRES

APPLE TREE proved difficult to load. Trainer V Rhind was advised that the filly must complete a satisfactory barrier test prior to racing again.

The start was delayed 3 minutes when SASSY SOX had to be resaddled prior to the start.

ELLATAS jumped out at the start bumping with and carrying MR FASHION outwards onto SASSY SOCKS.

Apprentice R Keogh (APPLE TREE) was reprimanded under AR 145 in that he weighed in, in excess of ½ a kilo over his declared weight. In not taking more severe action Stewards took into account his good record.

RACE 3 – KINGSMEADOWS HOTEL LIQUOR STAX 3YO SUPERVOBIS MAIDEN PLATE (2) – 1100 METRES

The start was delayed 4 minutes due to a delay at Mornington.

SMOKIN' TIGER proved difficult to load. Trainer C Goggin was advised that the filly must complete a satisfactory barrier test prior to racing again.

CHILDHOOD DREAMS jumped awkwardly, shifted ground inwards and bumped with EL CHEAPO.

EL CHEAPO was inclined to over race in the early stages and had to be steadied off the heels of SMOKIN' TIGER.

CHILDHOOD DREAMS layed in on the home turn.

Jockey S Maskiell (SMOKIN' TIGER) reported his mount layed out throughout the event.

Jockey L Smith (AMAZING PACE) reported that his mount jumped awkwardly and as a result brushed with ROSELANDS.

Stewards upgraded the track to GOOD (3) at 2.03 pm

RACE 4 – MOWBRAY LIQUOR STAX 3YO & UP SUPERVOBIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1400 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when the connections of SQUIRTINA, the 4th place getter wished to view the films and after doing so they were satisfied and correct weight was announced.

SQUIRTINA shifted out upon jumping and inconvenienced SH'BOURNE PHANTOM.

Approaching the 1300 metres GYPSY TRIOS layed in away from SQUIRTINA and inconvenienced NUKI.

Apprentice R Keogh (GIVEN SUNDAY) was reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 1300 metres he allowed his mount to shift ground inwards carrying SQUIRTINA in onto GYPSY TIOS which was hampered.

Apprentice R Keogh (GIVEN SUNDAY) pleaded guilty under AR 137(a) careless riding, in that near the 1150 metres he allowed his mount to shift ground inwards when insufficiently clear of SQUIRTINA causing it to be tightened in onto JUST A GEE GEE and lose its position. As a result of the interference BLACK JEUNEY and CAMOLIN were also inconvenienced. Appreciate Keogh's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of 2 Tasmanian race meetings, from midnight Tuesday 3 November until midnight Thursday 12 November. In arriving at penalty stewards took into account his guilty plea and his good record.

SUPEROLIC was inclined to race ungenerously at the 1200 and 800 metres.

SUPEROLIC was held up for the entire home straight.

RACE 5 – RIVERSIDE LIQUOR STAX 0-66 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Apprentice J Matthews to ride MARZOTTO ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

THE MOSS FACTOR was slow in his stride.

Near the 800 metres CATWEN BOY layed in bumping with the running rail before shifting ground outwards and hampering AMPHO POWER.

Approaching the home turn LION'S PAW bumped with and hampered BRODIE'S BOY.

Over the concluding stages MARZOTTO layed in away from AMPHO POWER brushing with HUNTER VINTAGE

A post race veterinary examination of ITS HIM revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 6 – BROWN BROTHERS CLASS 6 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

GOVERNOR GENERAL was a late scratching at 2.04 due to the track upgrade.

Approaching the home turn LIGHT SAVER was held up behind the tiring HELSINKI JONES.

RACE 7 – BUNDABERG RED (DIAGEO AUSTRALIA'S PRODUCT) CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Stewards granted permission for Jockey J Hamer to ride OBLADEE OBLADAH ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

Approaching the home turn RIPROVA was held up for a clear run.

Approaching the home turn FOOTBOLT, which was tiring, shifted in inconveniencing LOLA BELLE.

FIDDIAN GREEN was held up for a clear run between the 350 and 100 metres.

Over the concluding stages FOLLOW ME shifted ground outwards carrying RIPROVA out onto OBLADEE OBLADAH.

Jockey D Parish (BENBYRON) stated that the gelding got its tongue back and may have choked down.

RACE 8 – LIQUOR STAX OPEN HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Approaching the home turn I'M PADDY attempted to shift wide on the track and in doing so brushed OLD HANDS.

BUNDORAN BREEZE was momentarily held up near the 200 metres before shifting ground outwards to obtain a clear run.

RACE 9 – CONSTELLATION WINES CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

AUTUMN SUN was a late scratching at 4.24 pm due to the track upgrade.

Stewards granted permission for Jockey M Munday to ride HUSH MY NEDI ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

MISS EURIPIDES was resaddled prior to the start.

SEAHUNT was hampered at the start then was eased to the rear of the field.

Near the 400 metres MAYWYN'S PRIDE bumped with PINTERRY CHARLES.

On the home turned UMEAKA shifted ground inwards marginally and as a result SPRINGFIELD LIL had to be momentarily steadied.

Jockey L Smith (SUMMERS EVE) was severely reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the home turn he allowed his mount to shift inwards inconveniencing SOJU. In not taking more severe action Stewards took into account the racing manners of SUMMER EVE at that point of the event.

HUSH MY NEDI was held up for a clear run between the 500 and 250 metres.

TOUGHATHETOP was held up between the home turn and the 200 metres.
